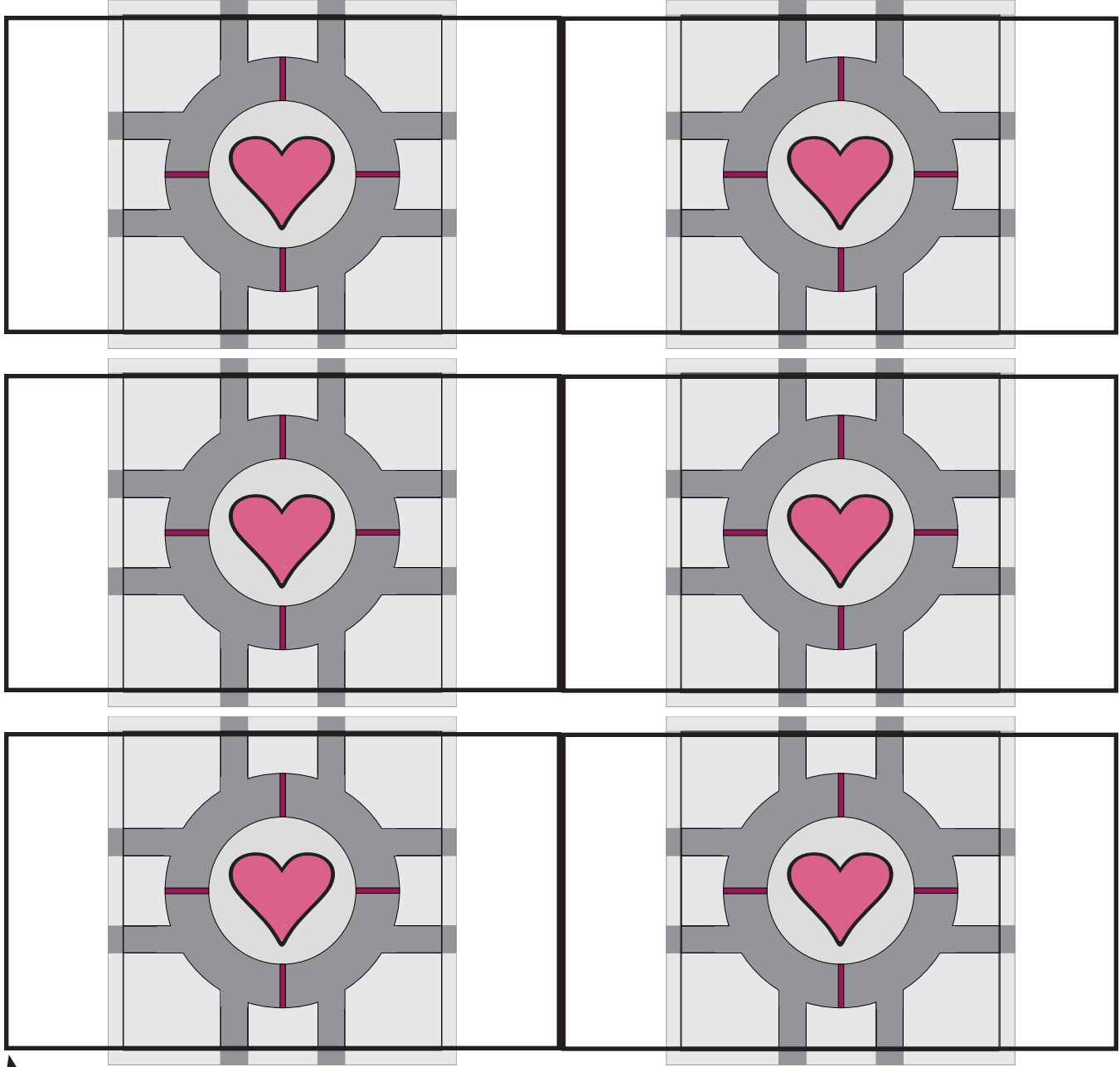


Business Card Companion Cube

→ Cut along dark lines

→ Don't worry about the colors bleeding over the edge. That's intentional and gives you more room to be a little sloppy in the cuts and folds.

→ Fold along light lines (optionally scoring the folds, first)

- Print two copies of this PDF printed on heavy cardstock — or print one copy and use 6 other business cards.
- Cut and fold where indicated. In total, you should now have 12 cards, at least 6 of which are companion cube faces.
- Follow the instructions at <http://nja.me/cubesteps> for constructing the cube. Use 6 cards to make a base cube. If using regular business cards for this, try to keep the printing on the inside of the cube and the business card backs on the outside.
- Once you have the base cube, use the companion cube faces to cover the flaps. Carefully attach them over the six sides of the cube. The flaps of the companion cube faces are folded completely under the flaps on the cube faces.
